

TERMS of PARTICIPATION

1. GENERAL INFORMATION

Taiga Journeys, herein called Taiga, is a partnership of Andrea & Christoph Altherr, registered in Whitehorse, Yukon, Canada. The following regulations are a binding part of the contract between Taiga and the participant, respectively, the booking sales agency.

2.1. REGISTRATION, CANCELLATION, PAYMENT

A registration is binding for both parties with written confirmation from Taiga. A non-refundable deposit of 20% (min. \$100.00) of the trip fee is required to hold a reservation; the balance is due 30 days prior the start of the arrangement. We accept cash, certified check, traveler check – sorry no credit cards.

2.2. Cancellation policy:	up to 60 days prior to start of arrangement:	20% (min \$100.00)
	59 to 30 days prior to start of arrangement	40%
	29 to 8 days prior to start of arrangement	80%
	7 to 0 days prior to start of arrangement	100%

The deadline is the day on which the written cancellation is received by Taiga. If the amount due has been paid to a sales agency, Taiga will only provide the arranged service if the payment has been forwarded to Taiga in time.

3. CANCELLATION BY TAIGA

Taiga reserves the right to cancel confirmed bookings due to circumstances on which Taiga has no influence on. For *example* inclement weather conditions or less than the specified minimum number of participants on a tour. In these cases Taiga will refund the amount already paid by the participant. Any other claims will be refused.

4. LIABILITY / INSURANCE

Activities like those organized by Taiga involve certain dangers. Our activities take part in remote areas with poor communication and where rescue or medical assistance is not available within reasonable time. Extensive insurance coverage is essential and this is the sole responsibility of the participants. We also recommend proper travel insurance, which also covers cancellation and delays.

With the registration the participant releases Taiga from any liability for loss of personal belongings and/or physical impairment. Taiga is not liable for non-performance of any arrangement if this is the fault of the participant. Taiga is not liable for any neglect of a third party, which is part of the agreement.

5. VARIOUS

Entering Canada and meeting the immigration regulations is the responsibility of the participant. The participant must strictly follow the directions given by Taiga, their employees or partners. Equipment, installations and gear of Taiga may be used only if agreed by and after receiving instructions from Taiga or its employees. Children and youth under age 19 must be under supervision of their parents or guardians at all times.

6. RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND WAIVER OF CLAIMS

Every participant must sign a release of liability and waiver of claims prior to any arrangement with Taiga and / or Andrea & Christoph Altherr. The laws of the Yukon Territory govern this contract and any legal concerns will be handled in the competent and fair courts in Whitehorse, Yukon, Canada.
